# National 600 Club Mail-O-Graphic Tournament

#### 1. Who can enter?

Any National 600 Club member. If not a member, submit application with entry form. Also must be a USBC member.

### 2. Where is tournament?

This is the good part. You don't have to travel. You use league scores. Can't go wrong.

# 3. When is tournament?

January 20 – Feburary 9, 2020. This is for 3 weeks but you use your highest series from that 3 week period. So, you get 3 chances for every entry. What other tournament does that?

## 4. What is the cost?

It is \$10.00 per league per division. Example: If you qualify for the senior division or the super senior division and you bowl in just one league and you want to enter those scores in both a regular division and a senior division, it would be \$20.00. But if you only want to enter one of the divisions, it would be \$10.00.

# 5. Is the tournament scratch or handicap?

Here is another good thing for this tournament. <u>There is a division for everyone</u>. It is handicap but we do have one scratch division that includes all averages. So we have 6 divisions.

Division SCR - Scratch Division

Division A – 180 average and above with handicap

Division B – 179 thru 165 inclusive with handicap

Division C – 164 and under average with handicap

Division S – Ages 55-69 with handicap (Proof of age required)

Division SS – Age 70 and over with handicap (Proof of age required)

## 6. What average do I use?

The average you use is the average as of date of participation. So when I receive your scores and your recap sheet (which is required), I use the average that is on the recap.

# 7. What is the handicap used for this tournament?

Handicap is 90% of the difference of 235 less your average.

## 8. What is the pay ratio?

Prize fund is returned 100% and will be based on at least one cash award for every five entries.

Can your state beat North Dakota for most entrants from a state?? They have won the past five or six years. Talk a fellow 600 club member into entering.

If your entry is postmarked by November 30, your name will be entered in a drawing for a quilted Christmas table runner.

#### **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- This tournament will be conducted by the National 600 Bowling Club, Inc. for its members. The tournament director will be appointed by the President of the Club.
- 2. An entrant must be a current adult female member of USBC or CTF. She must be a member of the National 600 Bowling Club, or may join when her entry is submitted.
- 3. There will be 6 Divisions in this Tournament:

SCRATCH DIVISON - ALL Averages - No separate average divisions for scratch

Division A -180 average and above (Handicap Division)

Division B -179 thru 165 inclusive (Handicap Division)

Division C -164 and under (Handicap Division)

Division S – age 55-69 Proof of age required (Handicap Division)

Division SS – age 70 and over Proof of age required (Handicap Division)

A \$10.00 entry fee for EACH Division entered

- 4. An entrant participating in the Senior division must be 55-69 **OR** the Super Senior division must be 70 or older **prior to January 1, 2020**. A copy of ID showing age must be submitted with entry form unless entered in previous year. An entrant in the S or SS divisions may also enter her scores in the other three (3) divisions A-B-C if qualified as a separate entry, requiring an additional fee. Also is eligible for the Scratch Division. (\$10.00 per division entered).
- 5. This tournament will be conducted by submitting "<u>highest 3 game total"</u> bowled in a USBC or CTF certified league during the dates of <u>January 20 through February 9, 2020</u>. \*If you bowl every other week, please contact the MOG Tournament Director at 701-718-9174.
- 6. Entrants will use current certified league average as of date of participation based on 21 games in the league from which they are submitting entry. All others will use a 235 average.
- 7. This tournament will be handicapped at 90% of the difference of 235 less your average.
- USBC rule 319d (tournament prize winning provision) and 319c (tournament average adjustment) will not apply. USBC rule # 202D will not apply. USBC rule 319a-3 (reporting incorrect averages) will apply.
- 9. If more than three (3) games are bowled in scheduled league play, the first three (3) games will be used. Leagues bowling six games (two 3 game series) may be entered for either series.
- 10. An entry may be submitted for each USBC or CTF certified league in which the participant is bowling. Photocopies of the entry form and score verification form will be accepted. An entrant may, however, cash only once in each division entered.
- 11. All scores must be bowled in a USBC or CTF certified league and will be verified.
- 12. The prize fund will be returned 100% and will be based on at least one cash award for every *five* entries in each division. Averages used will be verified prior to prize distribution.
- 13. Prize checks will be mailed to the winners by April 1, 2020.
- 14. An entry will be <u>declared ineligible</u> if the score verification form is returned without verification of league average *AND* a copy of the league recap sheet. <u>Do NOT send a standing sheet for verification of scores</u>. This does not show everything I need.

Failure to comply with the tournament rules will disqualify entries. Checks should be made payable to: National 600 Bowling Club, Inc. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks in addition to any bank charges. Results will be posted on the website. If you would like a copy of the results please send a stamped self addressed envelope along with your scores.
